
Boat Access to The Bugg House at Sunset Beach, NC

- The Sunset Beach boat slip is under the West side of the bridge along the intracoastal waterway.
- There are parking spaces to leave your trailer at the boat slip or you can leave the trailer in the driveway back at the Bugg House.
- Once leaving the boat slip, pass underneath the new bridge and turn RIGHT into Jinks Creek which is immediately past the first spoil island.
- Jinks Creek leads directly to Tubbs Inlet and the entrance to the feeder canal which leads to canals A, B, C, and D on the East side of Sunset Beach Island.
- Turn RIGHT into the feeder canal immediately before Tubbs Inlet.
- When you get to the end of the feeder canal, take a LEFT into Canal A. The Bugg House dock is the second from the end on the RIGHT. There are cleats on the dock but you should be prepared to bring tie off ropes in case none are present.
- The canal system and Tubbs Inlet are slowly silting in and are scheduled to be dredged before the 2020 summer season. Even at mid-tide navigation may be difficult in places.
- Our 17' center console boat sits in mud at our dock in extreme low tides. We do not recommend a boat larger than 17' until the canal system is dredged.
- Use extreme caution when navigating the canals, the feeder canal, Tubbs Inlet and Jinks Creek as sand bars are constantly moving and low tide can be very dangerous.
